February 2, 2025 Reflection: Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Mary & St. Joseph must have replayed this scene in their minds many times. When they presented their newborn son to the Lord in the Temple, they hadn't expected a man name Simeon to prophesy that Jesus would be "a light for revelation to the Gentiles" and "a sign that will be contradicted". But how and when would these things happen? And how would a sword pierce Mary's heart? The couple left the Temple amazed, but then returned to their ordinary lives; and, while the question of what would ultimately happen to Jesus hung over their heads, they knew God had given them a mission; to raise His Son. So, they have to stay in the Present and not let the future deter them. How often do you worry about the future, things you have no control over, or decisions and events which happen to someone else? Today, ask for the grace to focus on the responsibilities right in front of you, and trust that God will be with you, no matter what the future holds.

"Jesus, as I go about my day, I will place my trust in you."


