





February 16, 2025 Reflection: Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Can you imagine telling someone without a job or place to live, "Look at how much God has blessed you!" That's probably not something one should do, and it's not what Jesus is doing in today's Gospel. He is doing two things: 1) Proclaiming God's care and concern for those who are materially poor, and 2) Announcing blessings on "his disciples," who have "left everything and followed him". He is blessing all those who have accepted the poverty, the hardship, and the rejection they are experiencing as followers of Jesus. Jesus knows how challenging it can be to live out the call to discipleship. He knows there are days when you feel as if you're always swimming upstream. He sees the sacrifices you make to be generous and your humility as you strive to forgive those who have hurt you. If you can see yourself in ANY WAY, within these words, know that Jesus calls you blessed. Know that He is promising you all the joys of His Kingdom. And know He is blessing you *right here, right now!* As Jeremiah proclaimed in today's first reading, He is making you as strong as a "tree planted beside the waters". Even if you don't feel particularly blessed today, you can still take heart because Jesus is faithful to all His promises.

"Lord, help me to trust in your blessings when the call to discipleship feels hard."
