

March 2, 2025 Reflection: Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

A tree is meant to bear fruit, but as Sirach reminds us, the quantity and quality of the fruit are determined by the way the tree has been cared for. Jesus' words in today's Gospel echo Sirach's observations. Like the Old Testament sage, Jesus tells His disciples, "For every tree is known by its own fruit". But he also says, "A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good". That means, what you put into the "storehouse" of your heart and mind, what you take in to nourish yourself, eventually flows out of you, for better or worse. So, how can I fill the storehouse of my heart with good? There are some obvious answers: 1) Regular prayer can help you set down deep roots in and with the Lord; 2) Committing Scripture to memory can create behaviors (like giving, sharing, caring, being a blessing to others) to help you produce good fruit (like kindness, patience, courage, joy, grace, or empathy) and, 3) being around people and friends who share your faith and encourage you (to be a better example) and to produce and bear GOOD fruit. God created us all to bear good fruit and steer away from the bad fruit (like gossip, judgement, bitterness, jealousy, arrogance, envy, anger).



Let *The Magnificat Lenten Companion* be your guide through the holy season of Lent. This handy little booklet provides a series of inspiring daily reflections to help you and your family through EVERY precious day of Lent.

How Do I Prepare for Ash Wednesday?

To prepare for Ash Wednesday, you can reflect on your spiritual life, plan your Lenten practices (like fasting or giving something up or doing something more), attend a confession beforehand, and consider attending a special Ash Wednesday Mass where you will receive ashes on your forehead, signifying repentance and a commitment to a period of self-examination during Lent. Remember that Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat for most Catholics. Some key aspects of preparing for Ash Wednesday are:

Spiritual reflection: Take time to consider your relationship with God and areas where you want to grow spiritually during Lent.

Choose Lenten practices: Decide what you will give up or take on during Lent, such as fasting from certain foods, dedicating more time to prayer, or performing acts of charity.

Go to confession: Many people choose to go to confession before Ash Wednesday to start Lent with a clean slate.

Check your church schedule: Find out the time and location of your church's Ash Wednesday Mass and Stations of the Cross.

Understand the meaning of ashes: Ashes symbolize mortality and are accompanied by the phrase "Repent and believe in the Gospel" or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return".

Fasting and abstinence: On Ash Wednesday and Fridays during Lent, Catholics typically fast (eating only one full meal and two smaller meals) and abstain from meat.
